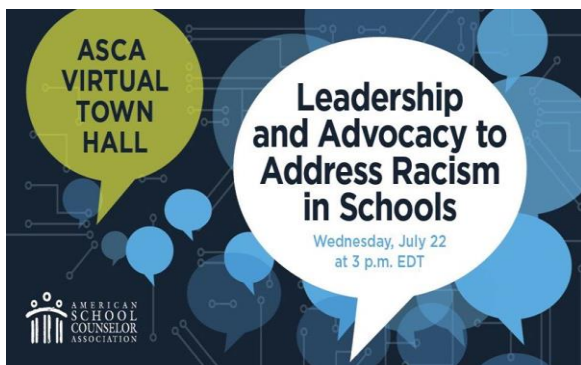




Social Emotional Learning on RACE
